- Skate Canada Fees must be added to your registration. All skaters must be registered with Skate Canada. Skate Canada fee is \$60 for upcoming season. Any discounts are not applicable to Skate Canada fees. Each skater only pays once per year (year starting September 1st-August 31st) no matter how many sessions or programs they

#### **PRECANSKATE**

PreCanskate is designed for the younger skater that is 3 or 4 years old. Must be 3 years old at the start of the program to register. The time is a little shorter (30 mins) for the younger skater and is perfect for the skater who has limited skating experience. All the skaters are around the same age and the groups will be done by the skaters ability. Lessons are given in a group format and led by an NCCP certified professional coach. Professional coaches are assisted by trained Program Assistants. Skaters progress at their own rate and coaches make sessions active using teaching aids, music and a wide variety of activities that create a fun environment and promote learning. The program is focused on fun and getting familiar with the basic skating skills. It is a fantastic starter program! As your skater develops they will be able to earn Canskate ribbons.

### **CANSKATE**

Canskate is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program, designed for beginners of all of ages (MUST be 4 years old as of start of program). You will be in a program that focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development. You will earn badges and other incentives as you learn fundamental skating skills. Lessons are given in a group format and led by an NCCP certified professional coach. Professional coaches are assisted by trained Program Assistants. Skaters progress at their own rate and coaches make sessions active using teaching aids, music and a wide variety of activities that create a fun environment and promote learning. CanSkate is the feeder program to all other Skate Canada skating programs, as well as preparing skaters for participation in hockey, speed skating and ringette.
